

Entry Details

First and foremost, thank you for choosing to spend time with us down at the NWSA and we hope that your visit is an enjoyable one.

We would like everyone to have a fantastic experience whilst at the academy so please read the below carefully and should you have any concerns or issues with it please let us know before your visit.

Our address is Unit 3c Wavertree Boulevard South, Liverpool, L7 9PF. Upon arrival there is a big yellow gate to the complex. The code for this gate is 1981. The barrier will lift automatically once you enter this code and the academy is directly in front of you as you proceed through the barrier. We have 4 parking spaces available directly in front of the building however, if these are full, please park in the overflow car parks as in the picture below:



We have an NHS contact centre next door to our academy so please keep the noise to a minimum outside of the building and as you enter.

There is a keycode on the door as you walk in, this changes daily so will be sent to you through your preferred contact method 24 hours in advance of your booking.

Please proceed to the left as you enter the building and around to the kitchen/break out area. You will have been allocated a table at booking time so please familiarise yourself with this before entering the main room. You will be able to spot the table signs on the walls for your corresponding table. Please consider your fellow members, whilst in the main room please place your mobile phones on silent or vibrate and please do not play music.

Tea and Coffee are available free of charge, the mugs are in the cupboard above the sink. Water is also available. Out of respect for other players, please clean up after yourself, wash and dry your mug and place it back in the cupboard once you have finished your visit. It is fine to bring food into the academy with you if you wish, however this is to be eaten or left in the breakout area. Please wash your hands following any handling of food and before you enter the main room to avoid transferring grease or dirt to the playing surfaces.

Upon completion of your hour, please tidy up and place all rubbish in the bins provided. Also, please take 2 minutes to brush the table. Snooker tables should be brushed from baulk end to black end. Brushes can be found below each table.
